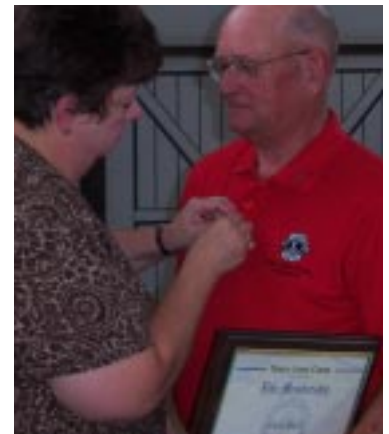


2009-2010 Hub Lions Club Officer Installation Cookout
